CARRIER AIR AVIATION SUBMARINE AIR GROUP 39 SUPPLIES SUBMARINERS WITH HER AIRCRAFT DURING DEPLOYMENT. Top left, an E1B or "Willy Fudd" approaches ZUMWALT'S flight deck. The "Fudd" is a long range aircraft and with her special equipment, in the dome on top of her fuselage, she can detect a submarine as far away as 100 miles from the ship. Center left, preparing to take off is an S2E "Tracker". The S2E is a close range detection aircraft and also carries bombs, torpedoes and depth charges to deal destruction to enemy submarines. Below, an SH3A helicopter gains altitude. These "Sea King" helicopters are also used for close range detection. They can hover over a spot and give an exact position of the submarine.
