

2. Please keep your colored boarding pass on your person as it grants you access to the Air Show and to the noon meal in your sponsor's mess. (See above schedule)

3. Guests are requested to remain with their sponsors or escorts at all times to avoid possible embarrassment and certain hazardous areas. Access below the hangar deck (main deck) is restricted to the lounge areas, messing (eating) areas, rest-room facilities, and ship's store areas. Guides will be stationed to help you avoid the restricted areas.

4. Static displays are located throughout the hangar bays. Aircraft displays are in hangar bay #2.

5. All guests are requested to eat the noon meal with their sponsors according to the schedule set forth, which is determined by the color of your boarding pass. Three increments have been scheduled for the noon meal so that all guests can be accommodated at a minimum of inconvenience to you. Please abide by the schedule, which will result in shorter lines and allow sufficient time to clean up and prepare for the next increment. (See schedule for meal hours)

6. Your cooperation is further solicited in following the schedule for the three air shows. The space on the island structure can accommodate a limited number for each show and the access to these vantage points is severely limited. Again the groups will be scheduled by the color of your boarding passes. The air show will also be televised on the ship's closed circuit TV for those who desire to watch in comfort.

7. The ladies "powder rooms" are located:

(1) On the main deck, forward starboard side in officers' country (A 105-L);

(2) On the second deck aft, adjacent to the First Class Lounge (down the double ladder starboard side of hangar bay #3);

(3) On the second deck, starboard side just forward of the Wardroom (down the ladder starboard side of hangar bay #1). They are all well marked and you may ask anyone in uniform for directions.

8. The men's "heads" are placed throughout the ship primarily on the second deck. They are also labeled and directions may be obtained from anyone in uniform.

9. Air shows, meal times and organized tours will commence from Hangar Bay #1 as called away on the LMC (the ship's public address system). Please be prompt.
