(con't. from page 9) Bernington was only a phase of the exercise, Bead Stringer. There were 22 other ships and a total of nine air units participating. Nearly every size and shape of ship in the U. S. Navy were in the exercise from small PT boats to huge attack aircraft carriers.

Advance training in surface warfare tactics, anti-air warfare, shore bombardment, anti-PT boat operations and antisubmarine warfare reflected the realistic emphasis placed on the numerous ships and air units participating in the exercise.
