WHILE OUT AT SEA, WHY DOES THE CREW HAVE TO BE IN THE 'UNIFORM OF THE DAY' WHILE RESIDING IN THE LIBRARY AND ATTENDING THE MOVIES IN MANGAR BAY #1?
