Atomic Sub Nautilus Due In WESTPAC

The world's first atomicpowered submarine, USS NAUTILUS, departed about Nay 15 for the Yest coast where she will be under the operational control of Admiral Pelix 8, Stump, USN, Compander in Chief, U.S. Pacific Pleet, for a two month period, the Navs smounced recently.

The purpose of the visit is to familiarize Pacific Fleet personnel with nuclear-powered submarines and to provide trainPacific Fiest. This is in keeping with the Nawy's policy of indectrinating personnel in new seepons mystems and concepts, the present time three atomicpowered submarines, the Submarines, (SSN 583), SCAMP (SSN 588), and HALIBUT (SSN 587), are until construction at Marc Island Naval Shipyard, Valley (California, These three are scheduled for coveration with
