Sept. 27, 1945

Arrived at Eniwetok which is
one of the Marshall Islands just a
few hundred miles north of the
Equator

Painted ships, and loaded supplies

Oct. 7, 1945

Left Eniwetok are heading
north. The rumor is, Tokyo
again
