Enning J. B. Hong, a photoglassystaticty of NEW 222 was the principal of our most waird crash landing. He was Jumped by ensay fighters over Kyushu, his wingams shatigges, and his our Helicat bedly damaged. He made it back, and had to land without the use of his flaps. His hook failed to catch and arresting wire, and he makkam sailed through two barriers, his F6 breaking up as he screeched through, The Helicat's engine stayed aboard, but Heag and the rest of his plane alid over the side. He was rescued uninjured by a destroyer. Lisut. R.F. Klingerman, a night fighter pilot of WF 82, hang up an most outstanding record on the night of 13 April when he was sectored out mine after four different Jsp smopper planes. He located each of them and shot them all doord

Throughout this period af the Jape continued to step up their Mandkase raids on our lines over chinawa, and upon our shipping lying off the beach. There Kamikase raids made several "field days" for our Coreair and Hellast pilate, On 6 April; becomington fighters got 31 planes enroute to Okinass without losing a single plane. A week later, the equatron stot down 34 Jape incee day, one of our pilate being downed in the process. (He was picked up later by a rescur plane).

6 April 1945 was mother one of the Bennington's Luck days, At 1300 our redars picked up a number of Boyles approaching our Group about 75 miles distant, Visibility was good except for some masty low-Liying clouds. A fighter skikks strike had returned and a number of Bellects were in the landing circle. Very canually almost leisurely, another fighter dropped out of the clouds astern and dove in for our fantail in a fast, turning power glide. At a range of about 500 yards he speayed our flight dock with a burset from his 500. At the same instant some 20m slung caught his inside his engine couling, followed by several 40ms hits, and he fell off and hit the water only fifty feet from our screws and ruiders, exploding as he hit. His carburstor bounced up intent on the flight deck aft. Bennington camualties were incidentally seweral men studing on the fantail \$ dowe for sover,
