battle stations, with little alogo desimabilet like health-berved "on stations." seaming the sides interminably for bothes or any unusual soverents or activities; title putting on ant taking off our flank car as the need arose; stands standing by our guns, and in our various cuidales throughout the ship's vant interior, waiting and waiching, really for snything that sight come.

On 28 July the Dennington was in an area approximately 100 miles south to Sidkoku, and our stribes were directed against Aspaness shipping targets including an les class battleship. During runs on this vessel three hits ware also scored on an Amngi class carrier moved to the dook at Mitquico Jima, causing explasions and firms on her right Might dook, Airfields were also strated effectively, On 30 July stribes were maintained a ainst the Kobe-Nagoya gras, Hagare were damaged abouting and planes destroyed on the ground. In addition, many machiding and strating attacks were made on revoluent areas, During the afternoon of the 30th, a boggy was shot down 63 miles (pen our formation, Jap offensive tries were Namesday redshire seasor.

From the 2nd to the 4th of August, we operated south of the fermaling area to avoid a typhoon, and for several days colloring were undermay once more for additional limmin offensives. On 6 August we were in a position about 100 miles off the coast of northeast limmins, Mary begins, mace were reported in the saming, but none were shot down. Two begins, however, were splashed at a distance from the mich quarker the mich quarker the late of termoon.

On 9 and 10 August we launched strikes and sweeps syminat sirticals and shipping in northern Homelas, flying support missions on the 9th for the naval booksarisent of Kanalisi. On 13 August we were about 150 miles east of Tokyo, launching strikes against the Tokyo Shibauwe Electric Company, a specially potent target.
