On 8 May we were highly honored by the visit of five admirals and two generals of the Chinese Navy and Air Porce. The visiting dignitaries were briefed on antisubmarine warfare by Admiral Maphereon and then watched an air show which domonstrated the capabilities of the EBMENEOTON'S SH-3A turbojet helicopters, S-22 "Trackores" and A-lb jet interceptors.

Following the demonstration, the guests were given a first hand look at the various aircraft in the hangar bay and toured key shipboard facilities.

When you receive this latter, BERGINGTON'S now will have been away from our homepout of Long Beach, California for eight weeks. The ship has travelled approximately 12,000 miles. We are now in Marila Bay anchored in view of the city and Corregion Feland, the fortress of World Mar II. Today the island is primarily a showplace for visitors.
