

You're not done, yet. Now you take the ferry to Kowloon, for which you'll have to dig down into your pocket for second class fare of about 5¢. In Kowloon, double-decked busses cover all points of the city. One of the musts is Shanghai Street, a slice of "Old China".

To see the New Territories, which old China hands say is a replica of life in the interior of China before the coming of the Communists, take the #16 bus at the Jordan Road Ferry Wharf for Castle Peak.
