

Nuclear Warhead Fired In 1st Live Polaris Test

Washington (AFPS)-The United States has successfully exploded its first missile-borne nuclear warhead at the Christmas Island test area in the Pacific. The warhead was carried aloft by a Polaris missile fired from the submarine Ethan Allen. The missile apparently scored a near bullseve after its 1.400

mile flight over the Pacific. head was dropped "right in the pickle barrel," according
