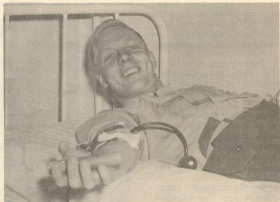
Two drives will be held; the first March 4-8, and the second March 11-15. Any crewmember who donates will rate the liberty.
