

A Word From Personnel

RE-ENLISTMENT OF STEWARDS

In accordance with BuPers Instruction 1133.16, personnel in the Steward rating (except E-8s and E-9s) cannot reenlist to acquire over twenty years service without approval from BuPers. Stewards approaching twenty years service, and who wish to reenlist, must submit an application via the Commanding Officer one year prior to the expiration of their enlistment.

All other personnel may reenlist to acquire service up to thirty years active duty. BuPers approval must be obtained to reenlist over thirty years.

TRANSFER TO FLEET RESERVE WITH 17½ YEARS SERVICE IS POSSIBLE

Counting constructive service, it is possible to be eligible for transfer to the Fleet Reserve with less than 17½ years service. An individual who enlisted the day prior to his 18th birthday and who reenlists three months early each time for the minimum period of enlistment will be eligible for transfer to the Fleet Reserve with 17 years, three months and one day active duty. No constructive service is accumulated for reenlistments more than three months early.

Although the preceding example doesn't happen very often, constructive service helps almost everyone. To compute constructive service, count minority enlistments as four years and enlistments ended within three months of expiration as completed.
